**Who we are?:** The Centre Québécois sur les Matériaux Fonctionnels (CQMF)-Quebec Center for Advanced Materials (QCAM) is a strategic research cluster funded by the Fonds de recherche Nature et technologies. Over 100 researchers and 700 students (including postdoctoral fellows), it is one of the largest materials science and engineering centers in Canada. Activities are focused around three fundamental research themes, polymer chemistry, molecular self-assembly, and nanoscience, to develop materials, devices, and technologies for the critical societal needs represented by our applied research axes: advanced materials for biomedical applications, energy, and environment and sustainable development.

We have four levels of sponsorship with different rewards:
