Timothy M. Swager is the John D. MacArthur Professor of Chemistry and the Director, Deshpande Center for Technological Innovation at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He has more than 475 peer-reviewed papers and 100 issued/pending patents. Swager's honors include: Election to the National Academy of Sciences, an Honorary Doctorate from Montana State University, the Linus Pauling Medal, and the Lemelson-MIT Award for Invention and Innovation. His research interests are in design, synthesis, and study of organic-based electronic, sensory, membrane, high-strength, liquid crystalline, and colloid materials. He is the scientific co-founder of DyNuPol, Iptyx, PolyJoule, C₂ Sense, and Xibus Systems.
